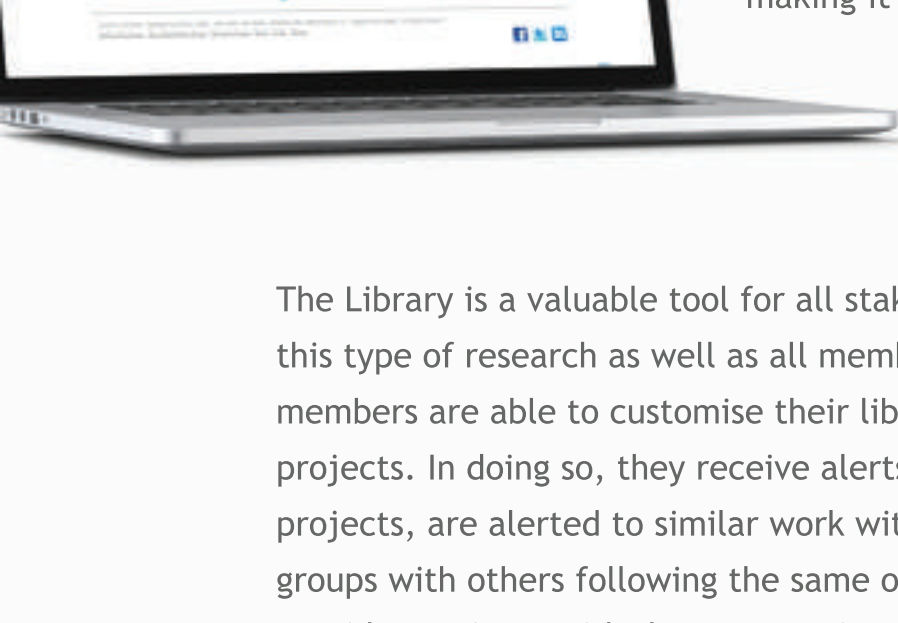




# DANDELION'S SEED PLATFORM

DANDELION has developed an exciting online collaborative platform, designed specifically for the communication of SSH/IIRS research results in a contextualized format using technology based on that developed originally for the innovative SEED Research Library. The platform is now live and project partners are working with selected SSH/IIRS projects to populate it with the first collection of content.



The DANDELION SEED Research Library offers projects the opportunity to display their results in an attractive, multi-media format called a SEED. As well as displaying this content, projects are also able to integrate their social media activity into the SEED, making it available in one online space.

The Library is a valuable tool for all stakeholders involved in or with an interest in this type of research as well as all members of society who benefit from it. Library members are able to customise their library and choose to "follow" favourite projects. In doing so, they receive alerts about new work and results from these projects, are alerted to similar work within their selected sectors and form interest groups with others following the same or similar projects. This functionality also provides projects with the opportunity to communicate directly with all stakeholders who they know have an interest in their work - active, multi-way communication.

Library members and participating projects also have open lines of communication and can share information within a project's SEED, meaning on-going discussion can take place within the context of that project's work.

Meanwhile, members are also able to search the database to discover those who share interests and discover what work they have done or are doing as well as which projects they have been or are involved in.

Finally, projects that end remain in the Library, which will become over the years a hugely valuable repository for SSH/IIRS research information and an important asset for the research community, policy makers and the EU to ensure results are not lost or work duplicated unnecessarily.

All SSH/IIRS projects are free to join the DANDELION SEED Research Library and full support is offered to those who need help in creating the most valuable SEED to attract followers.

So, be part of an on-going, vibrant resource that exposes your research results to a growing audience that cuts across all sectors of society and places you in a community where ideas can be openly shared.

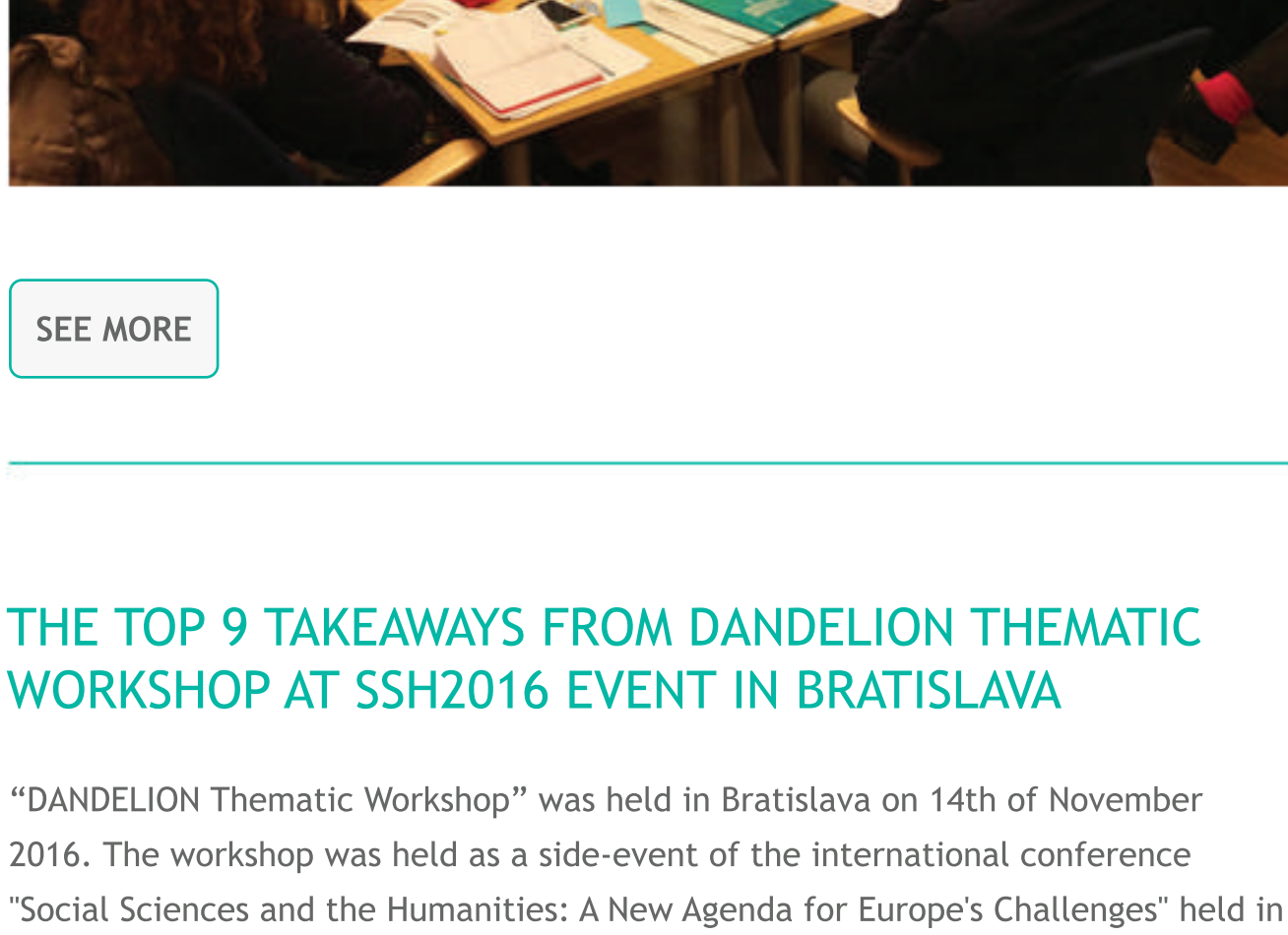


## KEY CONCLUSIONS FROM QUADRUPLE HELIX WORKSHOP IN BRUSSELS

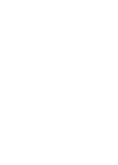

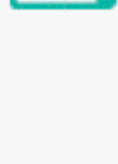
